In June 2017, the overall Consumer Price Index was 192.26, a 0.61 percent increase over the May 2017 overall index of 190.15

On an annual basis the overall index increased by 8.43 percent from June 2016 to June 2017. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 9.00 percent whilst Non-Food Products and Services rose by 7.44 percent.

From June 2016 to June 2017, within the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages, 'Fish and fish products' increased by 13.13 percent, 'Meat and meat products' increased by 11.50 percent and 'Bread and Cereal' increased by 8.99 percent.

For the Non-Food items, major increases were recorded by 'Footwear', 'Clothing, Garments and tailoring services 'and 'Electricity, Gas and other Fuels' which rose by 13.43 percent, 8.12 percent and 5.49 percent respectively.

During the months of May 2017 to June 2017, 'Oils and Fats', 'Fruits and Nuts', and 'Milk, Cheese and Eggs' shows the highest increase in percentage with 1.06 percent, 0.99 percent, and 0.98 percent respectively.

Using the 12 months-moving-average measure, inflation rate was 8.07 percent in June 2017 compared to 7.96 percent recorded in May 2017.

Figure 1: Annual changes – Comparison with the same month of the previous year (June 2016 –June 2017)





Figure 2: Monthly changes - Comparison with the previous month: May 2017 to June 2017
