In March 2018, the overall Consumer Price Index was 201.59, a 0.50 percent increase over the February 2018 overall index of 200.58.

On an annual basis the overall index increased by 6.53 percent from March 2017 to March 2018. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 6.36 percent whilst Non-Food Products and Services rose by 6.83 percent.

From March 2017 to March 2018, within the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages, 'Fruits and Nuts' increased by 8.88 percent, 'Meat and meat products' increased by 8.64 percent, 'Fish and fish products' increased by 8.44 percent, and 'Milk Cheese and Eggs' increased by 6.17 percent.

For the Non-Food items, major increases were recorded by 'Footwear', 'Clothing, Garments and tailoring services' and 'Electricity, Gas and other Fuels' which rose by 9.98 percent, 7.25 percent and 6.67 percent respectively.

During the months of February 2018 to March 2018, 'Milk, Cheese and Eggs', 'Meat and Meat Products', 'Fish and Fish products, and 'Bread and Cereals', shows the highest increase in percentage with 1.01 percent, 0.99 percent, 0.97 percent and 0.54 percent respectively.

Using the 12 months-moving-average measure, inflation rate was 7.44 percent in March 2018 compared to 7.62 percent recorded in February 2018.

Figure 1: Annual changes – Comparison with the same month of the previous year (March 2017 – March 2018)





Figure 2: Monthly changes - Comparison with the previous month: February 2018 to March 2018
