In May 2018, the overall Consumer Price Index was 203.57, a 0.44 percent increase over the April 2018 overall index of 202.69.

On an annual basis the overall index increased by 6.53 percent from May 2017 to May 2018. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 6.24 percent whilst Non-Food Products and Services rose by 7.04 percent.

From May 2017 to May 2018, within the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages, 'Fruits and Nuts' increased by 9.17 percent, 'Fish and fish products' increased by 8.46 percent, 'Meat and Meat Products' increased by 7.74 percent and 'Bread and Cereals' increased by 7.03 percent.

For the Non-Food items, major increases were recorded by 'Footwear', 'Clothing, Garments and tailoring services' and 'Electricity, Gas and other Fuels' which rose by 10.59 percent, 6.67 percent and 6.63 percent respectively.

During the months of April 2018 to May 2018, 'Fruits and Nuts' and 'Bread shows the highest increase in percentage with 1.62 percent and 0.71 percent respectively.

Using the 12 months-moving-average measure, inflation rate was 7.12 percent in May 2018 compared to 7.27 percent recorded in April 2018.

Figure 1: Annual changes – Comparison with the same month of the previous year (May 2017 – May 2018)





Figure 2: Monthly changes - Comparison with the previous month: April 2018 to May 2018
