In June 2018, the overall Consumer Price Index was 204.67, a 0.54 percent increase over the May 2018 overall index of 203.57.

On an annual basis the overall index increased by 6.46 percent from June 2017 to June 2018. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 6.25 percent whilst Non-Food Products and Services rose by 6.84 percent.

From June 2017 to June 2018, within the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages, 'Fruits and Nuts' increased by 8.99 percent, 'Fish and fish products' increased by 8.42 percent, 'Meat and Meat Products' increased by 8.28 percent and 'Bread and Cereals' increased by 6.81 percent.

For the Non-Food items, major increases were recorded by 'Footwear', 'Clothing, Garments and tailoring services' and 'Electricity, Gas and other Fuels' which rose by 9.33 percent, 6.56 percent and 5.88 percent respectively.

During the months of May 2018 to June 2018, 'Milk, Cheese and Eggs', 'Meat and Meat Products', 'Fruits and Nuts' and 'Fish and Fish Products' shows the highest increase in percentage with 1.06 percent, 0.90 percent, 0.82 percent and 0.69 percent respectively.

Using the 12 months-moving-average measure, inflation rate was 6.96 percent in June 2018 compared to 7.12 percent recorded in May 2018.

Figure 1: Annual changes – Comparison with the same month of the previous year (June 2017 – June 2018)





Figure 2: Monthly changes - Comparison with the previous month: May 2018 to June 2018
