In August 2018, the overall Consumer Price Index was 207.12, a 0.67 percent increase over the July 2018 overall index of 205.75.

On an annual basis the overall index increased by 6.68 percent from August 2017 to August 2018. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 6.56 percent whilst Non-Food Products and Services rose by 6.90 percent.

From August 2017 to August 2018, within the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages, 'Fruits and Nuts' increased by 9.49 percent, 'Fish and fish products' increased by 8.44 percent, 'Meat and Meat Products' increased by 8.03 percent and 'Bread and Cereals' increased by 7.53 percent.

For the Non-Food items, major increases were recorded by 'Footwear', 'Electricity, Gas and other Fuels' and 'Clothing, Garments and tailoring services' which rose by 9.73 percent, 7.11 percent and 6.93 percent respectively.

During the months of July 2018 to August 2018, 'Meat and Meat Product', 'Bread and Cereals', 'Oils and Fats' and 'Fruits and Nuts' shows the highest increase in percentage with 0.83 percent, 0.79 percent, 0.75 percent and 0.60 percent respectively.

Using the 12 months-moving-average measure, inflation rate was 6.75 percent in August 2018 compared to 6.85 percent recorded in July 2018.

Figure 1: Annual changes – Comparison with the same month of the previous year (August 2017 – August 2018)





Figure 2: Monthly changes - Comparison with the previous month: July 2018 to August 2018



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
