Important announcement

With the publication of the January 2020 index, GBOS has updated the official CPI series. This involves updating the weights and product basket as well as a number of methodological improvements. These updates improve the transparency, relevance and representativity of the CPI. For the first time, GBoS will also be calculating CPI indexes for urban and rural areas. These estimates are available on our website. See www.gbosdata.org/downloads, www.gambia.opendataforafrica.org/nsdp or the Annex to this release for full details.

To highlight these improvements, the long run CPI index has been re-referenced (rescaled) to January 2020=100. Please note that historical inflation rates are unaffected by this rescaling.

From November 2019 to November 2020, the year on year All-items Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation rate increased by 5.76 percent. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 6.49 percent whilst Non-Food Products rose by 4.88 percent.

In November 2020, the All-items CPI index was 105.00, an increase of 0.7 percent over the October 2020 All-items index of 104.29

From November 2019 to November 2020, within Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages, 'Fish' increased by 24.77 percent, 'Oils and Fats' increased by 11.73 percent, 'Bread and Cereals' increase by 5.91, 'Fruits and Nuts' increased by 4.81 percent, and 'Milk, 'Cheese and eggs' increased by 3.3 percent.

Over the same period, for the Non-Food products, major increases were recorded by 'Education',85.41 percent, 'Miscellaneous', 28.97 percent, 'Hotels, Cafes and Restaurant', 10.52 percent, 'Furnishing, Household Equipment, etc.', 7.57 percent, 'Transport' 5.23 percent, 'Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics', 2.93 percent, and 'Clothing and Footwear', 3.28 percent.

From October 2020 to November 2020, the highest inflation rates were for 'Milk Cheese and Eggs', 3.37 percent, 'Oils and Fats', 1.68 percent, 'Meat' 1.58 percent, 'Sugar, Jam, Honey and Sweets', 1.51 percent, and 'Vegetables, root crops and tubers', 0.63 percent.

Using the 12 months-moving-average measure, the annual inflation rate was 5.1 percent in November 2020 compared to 5.1 percent recorded in October 2020.




Figure 2: Monthly changes - Comparison with the previous month: October 2020 to November 2020
