## Annex: 2025 - The Gambia

### SDG Monitoring Survey Methodology

The 2025 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) Monitoring Survey represents the second round of SDG-focused data collection conducted by the Gambia Bureau of Statistics (GBoS), following the baseline survey round in 2021. This round was designed to generate updated, high-quality, and disaggregated data for monitoring national progress on selected SDG indicators and informing the implementation of The Gambia's Recovery-Focused National Development Plan (2023–2027), the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, and the African Union Agenda 2063.

The 2025 round builds on the methodological foundations established in 2021, enabling comparisons over time and providing valuable insights into trends and disparities across population groups. Both survey rounds included field-tested instruments, interviewer training, and digital data collection systems to ensure accuracy, timeliness, and policy relevance of the data collected.

## 1. Survey Instruments

Both survey rounds were conducted to inform the Voluntary National Review (VNR) by addressing existing data gaps. The 2021 questionnaire was developed in consultation with various SDG focal points and includes questions that measure indicators under SDG 16 as well as other SDGs.

**Household Questionnaire:** Administered to the head of household or an informed member, it captured information on household composition, living conditions, access to basic services, and other household-level indicators aligned with the SDGs.

**Individual Questionnaire:** Following the completion of the household survey module, one household member aged 15 or older was randomly selected using the Kish grid method to respond to an individual-level module. This module gathered data on education and training, discrimination, governance, safety, access to justice, and other personal experiences relevant to SDG monitoring.

## 2. Field Staff Training and Pre-Test

Field staff participated in a five-day training from 6th to 10th March 2025, covering interview techniques, use of CAPI (Computer-Assisted Personal Interviewing) devices, and ethical data collection practices.

A pre-test was conducted on 13th March 2025 in 18 enumeration areas not included in the main sample. This pre-test was essential for testing the digital data collection tools, evaluating enumerator preparedness, and refining the survey instruments. Insights gained informed final adjustments to both the questionnaires and field procedures.

## 3. Data Collection

The main fieldwork was conducted from 13th April to 7th May 2025. All interviews were completed using CAPI-enabled tablets, allowing for real-time data monitoring and quality checks by GBoS. Field operations were centrally supervised, with support mechanisms in place to ensure high response rates and adherence to protocols.

## 4. Key Quality Assurance Measures

The Gambia SDGs Monitoring Survey implemented several quality assurance measures to ensure data quality. The questionnaire underwent a pretest, which informed final adjustments to skip patterns, clarity, and logic. The CAPI application was developed with in-built validation checks, automated skip logic, and integrated offline maps using GPS data from the listing exercise to assist field teams in locating households. Data collected by enumerators was synced daily from supervisor tablets to a central server, where the data manager downloaded and shared it with editors for review. Editors used custom Stata do-files to run quality checks and provided timely feedback to interviewers in the field. In addition to remote monitoring, editors and members of the coordinating team conducted field visits to observe interviews, resolve issues, and ensure adherence to protocols.

### Household and Individual Response Rates

The 2025 Gambia SDG Monitoring Survey achieved a high response rate, demonstrating the effectiveness of the field procedures.

A total of 6040 eligible households were sampled. Interviews were successfully completed in 5,676 households, resulting in a household response rate of 95.3 per cent.

Within each household, one individual aged 15 years or older was randomly selected for the interview. Out of 5,676 eligible individuals, interviews were completed with 5,383 respondents, yielding an individual response rate of 94.8 per cent.

## 5. Sampling and Weighting Methodology

The 2025 SDGs Monitoring Survey represents the second SDG Monitoring Survey in The Gambia, designed to generate statistically robust estimates of SDG 16 and related indicators at the national level, as well as for urban and rural areas, and across the eight Local Government Areas (LGAs) of the country. The sampling framework delineated urban and rural areas within each of the eight LGAs as distinct strata. The survey's design parameters were derived from the preceding round of the SDG Monitoring Survey conducted during 2021, following a two-stage stratified cluster sampling methodology. This approach ensures the accuracy and reliability of the survey results, enabling effective monitoring and evaluation of SDG progress across geographic and demographic contexts.

### Sampling frame

The sampling frame for the selection of EAs was derived from the recently conducted 2024 Population and Housing Census, which covered the entire nation. In contrast, the 2021 SDG Monitoring Survey relied on the 2013 Census, which explains the slight deviation in the sampling between the two survey rounds. For census and survey purposes, the country is divided into eight Local Government Areas (LGAs): Banjul, Kanifing, Brikama, Mansakonko, Kerewan, Kuntaur, Janjanbureh, and Basse. Among these, Banjul and Kanifing are classified exclusively as urban areas. Within each LGA, urban and rural areas were demarcated as primary sampling strata, resulting in a total of 14 distinct strata. Each LGA is further divided into districts, which are subsequently segmented into settlements. An EA may encompass a single settlement, a group of smaller settlements, or a portion of a larger settlement. This hierarchical geographical structure allows for the country to be divided into clearly defined and manageable units, each explicitly categorized as urban or rural.

### Sample Size

The sample size was determined using the participation rate of youth (15-24) in technical or vocational programmes during the previous 12 months, as reported in the 2021 SDG Monitoring Survey. Accounting for a margin of error of 1.6 per cent, a design effect of 2.0, and an average household size of 8 (based on the recent Census), the sample size for each domain was calculated and adjusted for the design effect as follows:

$$n_{\text{total}} = n \cdot \frac{1}{\text{Design effect}}$$

From the 2021 Survey, the anticipated non-response rate is 5 per cent, and the final sample size was:

$$n_{\text{final}} = n_{\text{total}} \cdot \frac{1}{(1 - \text{nonresponse rate})}$$

Table 3 outlines the distribution of EAs and households across LGAs, categorized by type of residence (urban/rural). The selection of 20 households per EA was informed by several critical factors, including the design effect, budgetary limitations, and the time required for field teams to complete data collection within each EA. This resulted in the identification of 302 EAs for the survey.

## Sampling and Weighting

The 2025 Gambia SDGs Monitoring Survey employed a rigorous two-stage stratified cluster sampling methodology to ensure national representativeness and statistical accuracy for both household and individual-level indicators.

During the data management phase, the dataset was weighted to address the differential probabilities of selecting both EAs, households and individuals. The final weights were standardized before being applied to the dataset. This adjustment was essential because the sampling design, as previously described, is not self-weighting. Specifically, households were selected with unequal probabilities during the second stage of sampling. In the third stage, one individual (15+) was randomly selected from the list of individuals in the household roster. A detailed spreadsheet was developed to systematically document all relevant sampling parameters and selection probabilities, facilitating the calculation of the household design weights. These weights were further adjusted to account for household non-response, yielding the final sampling weights. The inverse of the probability of selection for each participant is the final individual weight.

## Sampling Design Overview

The first stage involved the selection of Enumeration Areas (EAs) from the 2024 census sampling frame, stratified by administrative region and urban-rural residence. Within each stratum, EAs were selected independently using Probability Proportional to Size (PPS), with the number of households in each EA serving as the measure of size. This method ensured that larger EAs had a higher chance of selection, maintaining proportional representation.

Following the EA selection, a nationwide household listing operation was undertaken to create an up-to-date frame for household selection within each sampled EA. In the second stage, a fixed number of

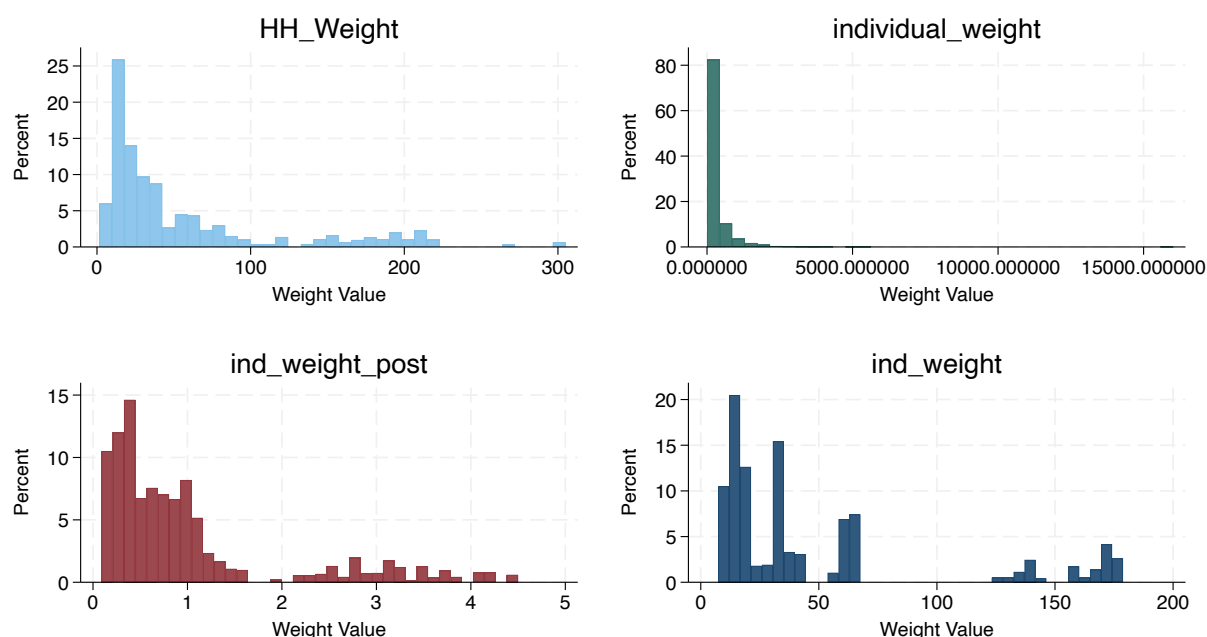
households (20) were systematically selected from the updated household lists in each EA. This approach allowed for equal probability of selection among households within each EA and ensured that the final household sample was self-weighting within strata. The Household Questionnaire is administered exclusively to the head of the household (or a knowledgeable adult representative if the head is unavailable), while one individual aged 15 years or older is randomly selected per household to complete the Individual Questionnaire using the Kish grid method with the selection algorithm pre-programmed into the CAPI system to ensure automated, impartial respondent selection.

## Weight Calculation Process

Sampling weights were computed in two stages and the final household weight is the product of the first-stage and second-stage weights.

1. **EA-Level Weights (First Stage):** The selection probability for each EA was calculated based on its size relative to the total size of its stratum. The EA weight is the inverse of its selection probability.
2. **Household-Level Weights (Second Stage):** Within each selected EA, the household selection probability was determined based on the number of households selected relative to the total number of households listed. The household weight is the inverse of this probability.

## Individual Weighting

The individual weight for each participant is calculated as the inverse of their total selection probability, accounting for: (1) the first stage selection probability (2) the household selection probability; and (3) the within-household selection probability, determined by the Kish method to ensure an unbiased, equal-probability selection of one eligible individual (aged 15+) per household.

## Post-Stratification Adjustment

To further improve the representativeness of the sample, a post-stratification adjustment was included using known population totals from the most recent census projections. The following variables were used for this adjustment:

- Sex (Male, Female)
- Urban/Rural Residence
- Administrative Region (8 regions)
- Age (15 adjusted 5-year bands)

Each respondent was assigned to a post-stratum defined by the cross-classification of these variables. The `ipfweight` procedure in Stata was used to calibrate the individual weights so that the marginal distributions of the weighted survey data matched the census totals. The resulting post-stratified weight (`ind\_weight`) reflects both the sampling design and population benchmarks, improving the accuracy of estimates, especially for subpopulations.

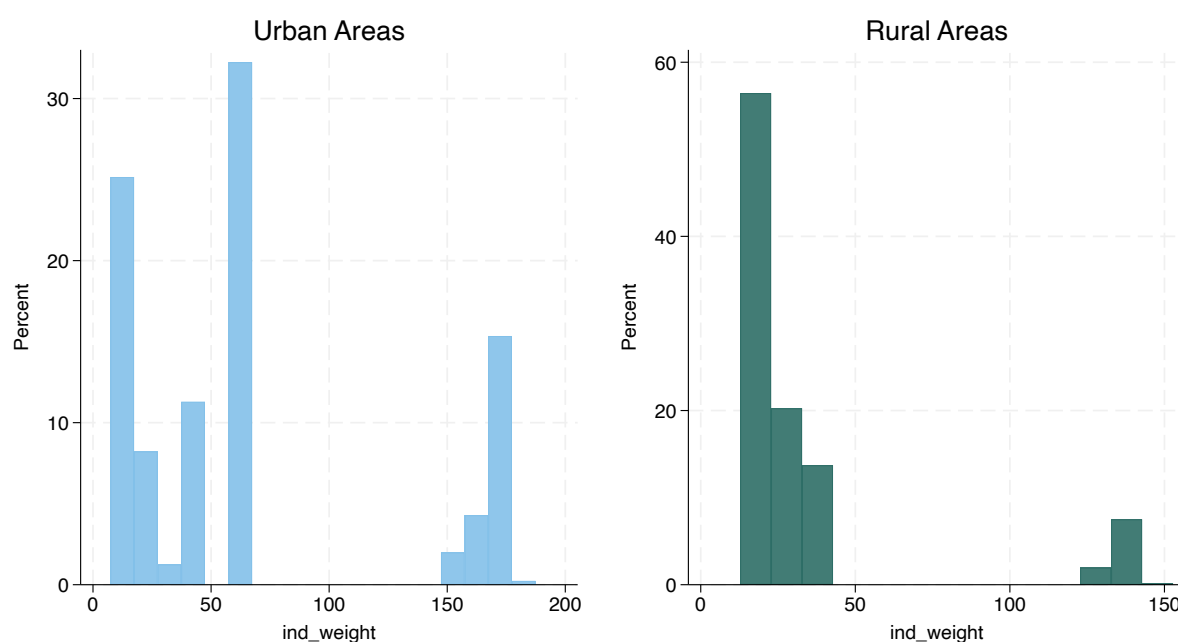
### Quality Assurance and Verification

To verify the effectiveness of the weighting and post-stratification process, several quality checks were performed. These included:

- Comparing weighted population distributions to census population totals.
- Estimating total populations for specific groups (e.g., youth aged 15–35) and verifying alignment with known demographic totals.
- Checking for extreme or zero weights and ensuring the absence of bias due to nonresponse or sub-sampling.

The implementation of this robust weighting methodology enhances the credibility and reliability of findings from the 2025 Gambia SDGs Monitoring Survey and ensures that the data can confidently inform national and international development indicators.

## Calculation of Sampling Errors

Given the complex sample design, design-based variance estimation was used, taking into account clustering and stratification.

The survey data were set using the `svyset` command as follows (STATA):

```
svyset hh1 [pw=ind_weight], strata(survey_strata)
```

- `hh1` is the primary sampling unit (EAs)
- `survey_strata` reflects the stratification variable used during sampling.

All survey estimates, including totals, means, proportions, and regression coefficients, were computed using Stata's `svy:` prefix to incorporate the survey design. This approach produces robust standard errors, confidence intervals, and design effect (DEFF) estimates, which are crucial for assessing the precision and reliability of indicators.

To assess the reliability of the survey findings, detailed tables outlining sampling errors and confidence intervals for key estimates were compiled. Sampling error quantifies the deviation between an estimate derived from the sample and the value that would have been obtained if the entire population had been surveyed under the same conditions. For each estimate, the tables provide the standard error, coefficient of variation (CV), 95 percent confidence interval, design effect (DEFF), and the number of observations, ensuring a comprehensive evaluation of the data's accuracy and robustness. The variance estimator for a total, as implemented in Stata, the analytical tool utilized by GBoS, can be expressed as follows:
