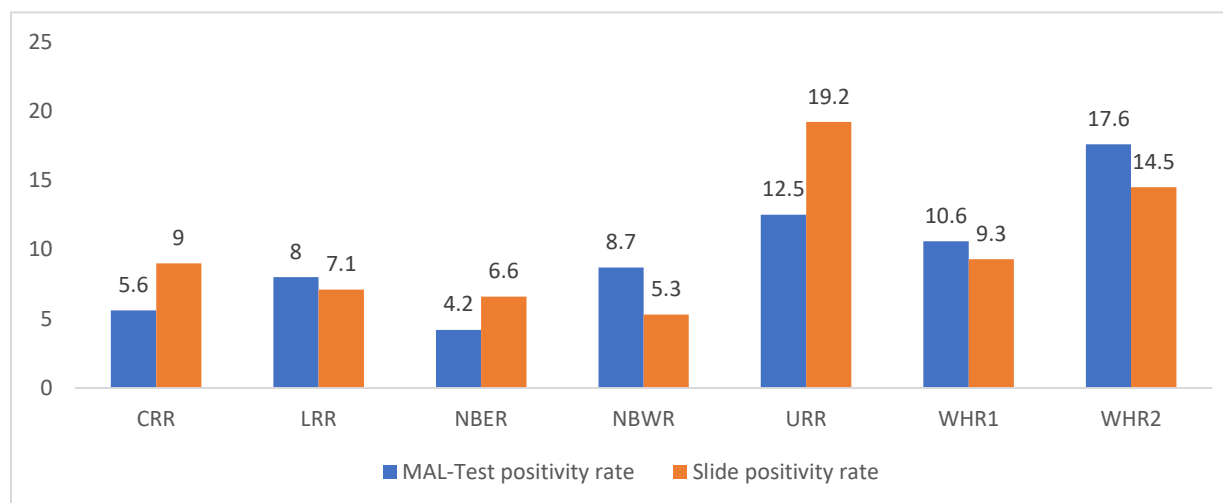

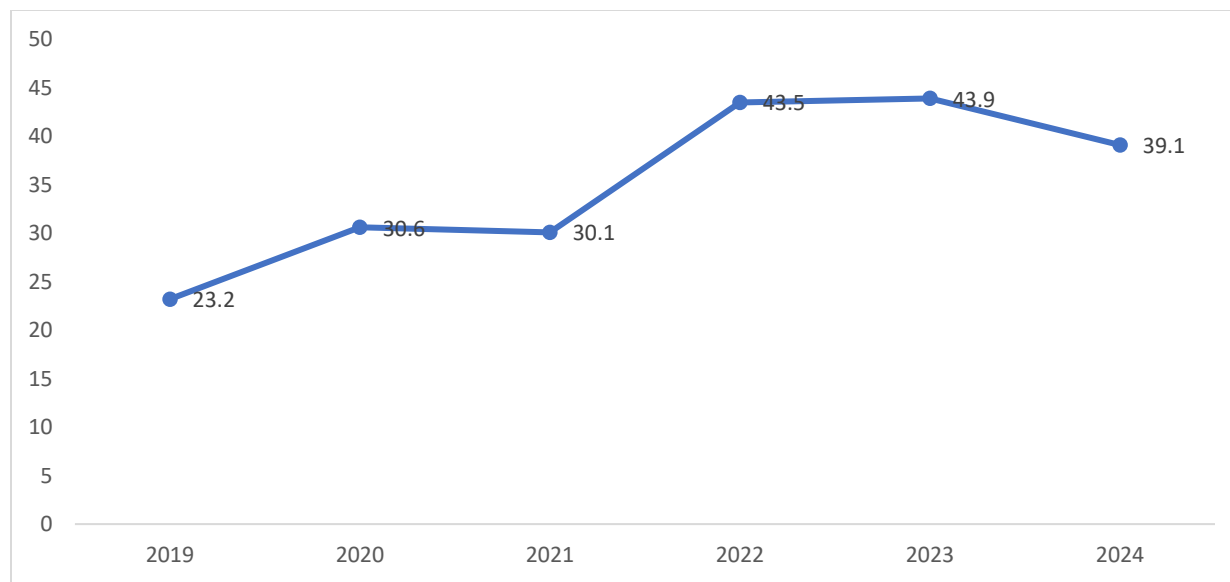

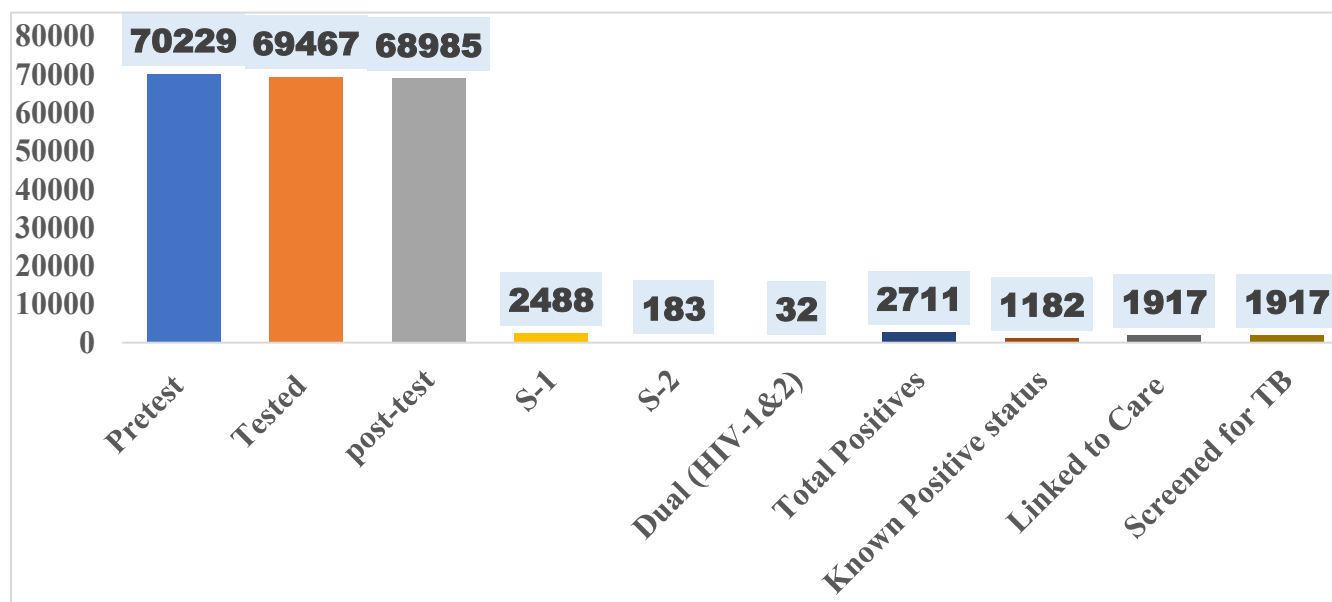
Figure 6.2: Reported Malaria cases per 1000 population from 2019 – 2024.

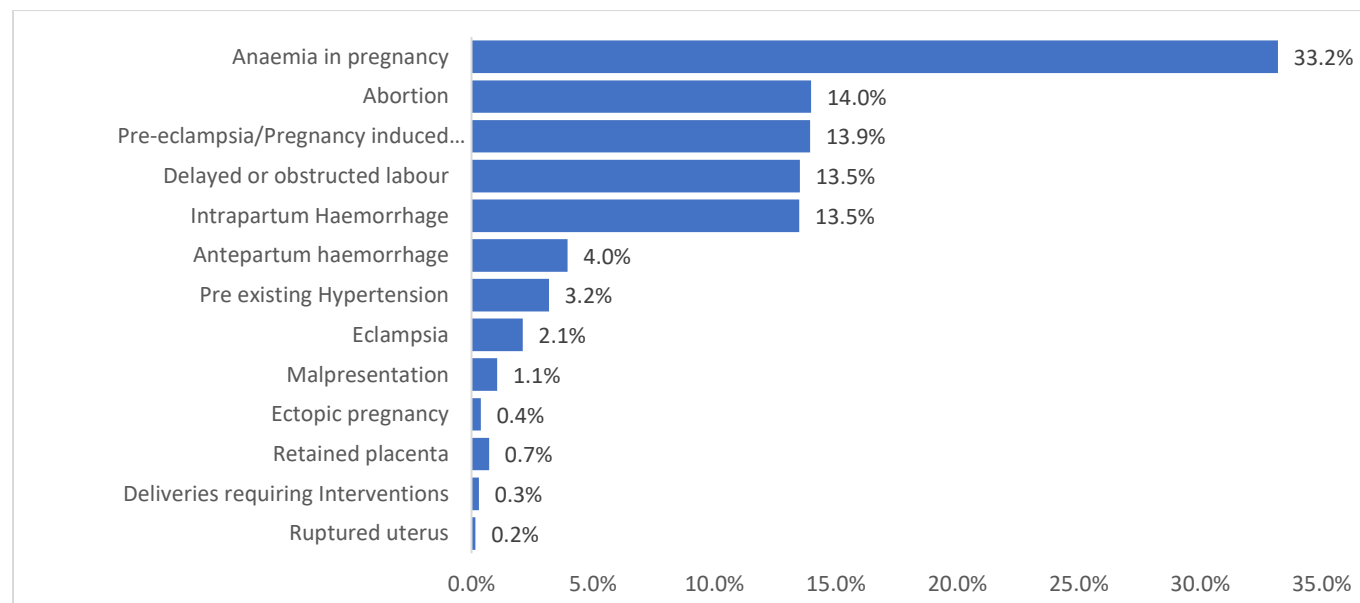

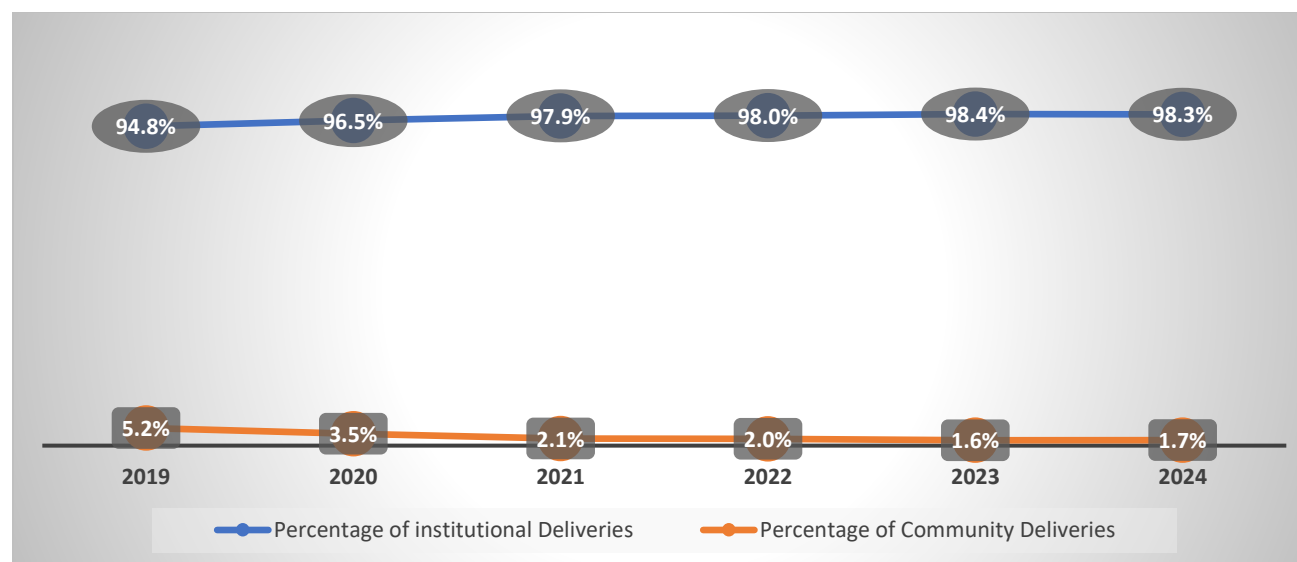

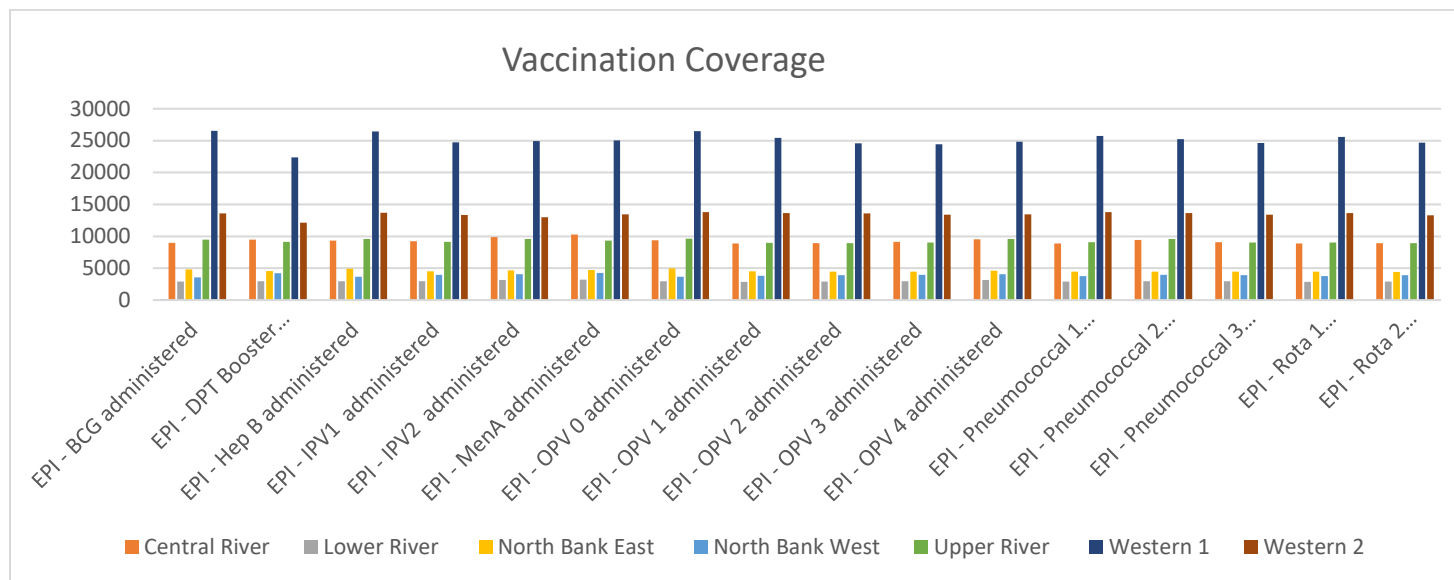

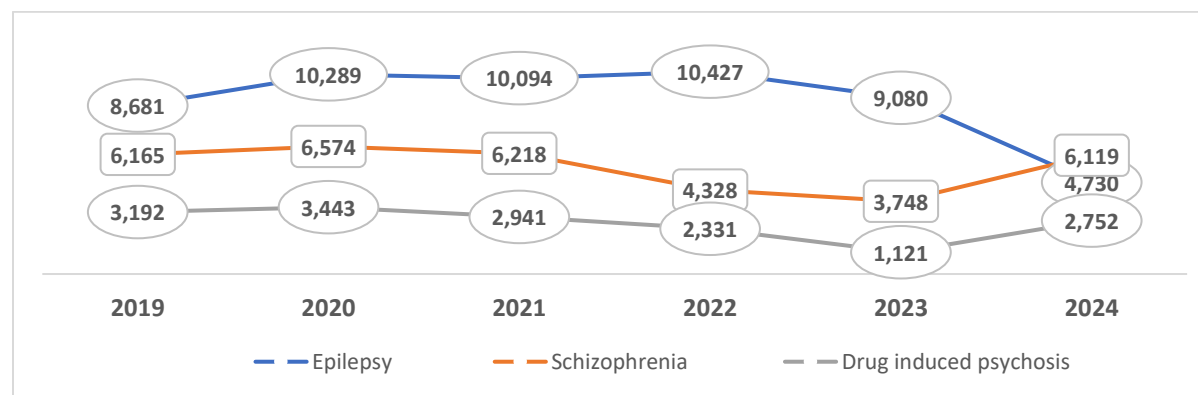
