In December 2016, the overall consumer Price Index was 185.35, a 1.38 percent increase over the November 2016 overall index of 183.35

On an annual basis the overall index increased by 7.88 percent from December 2015 to December 2016. Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages increased by 8.65 percent whilst Non Food Products and Services rose by 6.55 percent.

From December 2015 to December 2016, within the Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages, 'Meat and meat products' increased by 11.94 percent, 'Fish and fish products' 11.19 and 'Bread and Cereal' 9.32 percent.

For the Non Food items, the major increases were recorded by 'Footwear', 'Clothing Garments and tailoring services 'and 'Electricity Gas and other Fuels' which rose by 11.50 percent, 7.66 percent and 3.31 percent respectively.

During the months of November 2016 to December 2016, 'fish', 'bread and cereals', and 'Meat and meat products' show the highest increase in percentage of 1.08 percent, 0.91 percent, 0.80 percent respectively.

Using the 12 months-moving-average measure, inflation rate was about 7.05 percent, compared to 6.97 percent recorded in September 2016.

Figure 1: Annual changes - Comparison with the same month of the previous year. (Dec 2015 - Dec 2016)





Figure 2: Monthly changes - Comparison with the previous month: November 2016 to December 2016
